- Define, Clarify, and establish clear consistent expectations for morning arrival, transitions, and dismissal.
 - No Hall passes for the first and last 10 minutes of class.
 - Redirect the flow of traffic for breakfast.
 - Duty/Hallway Presence
 - $\circ~$ Team Rotation for late buses
- Clear Consistent Consequences for failure to comply.
- Document Transition Infractions (Link in Onenote)follow behavior matrix
